**STANDING ORDER: CHILD SUPPORT COMPUTATION PROCEDURES**

This Order applies to all domestic actions involving a child or children AND CHILD SUPPORT. These domestic actions include, but are not limited to, divorce, modification of child support, and modification of custody.

1. All Final Judgments and Agreements furnished to the Court for approval and/or entry must comply with the drafting mandates of O.C.G.A. §19-6-15. This may be accomplished through the use of the four page *Exhibit "AA": Child Support Computation*, available from the Clerk of Court, which may be incorporated into Agreements or Final Judgments.
2. In any contested cases as required by O.C.G.A. §19-6-15, the parties shall submit to the Court their proposed findings regarding the gross incomes of the father and the mother, the presence or absence of special circumstances, and the amount of child support. This shall be accomplished through the use of the four page *Exhibit "AA": Child Support Computation*, available from the Clerk of Court.

This order shall apply to all domestic actions involving a child or children and child support filed in this Court and shall be the standing order until further order or action by the judges of the Court. The terms and conditions hereof may be modified or amended by subsequent order of any judge of this Court or any judge sitting by designation in this Court in any individual case.

This supersedes the order dated January 25, 2005 included in the Case Management Internal Operating Procedure filed with the Clerk of Court on January 28, 2005.






